Before the pigmentation, your face will be measured in order to obtain a natural and perfect pigmentation, taking your normal profile into account. Using gamma sterilized special needles, needle nozzles and color return flow protection, (all disposable) the color pigments (certified according to the latest regulations and dermatologically tested) are deposited in the dermal layer of the skin. A tiny hair drawing with discreet background shading is done for the eyebrows. The lip contours are coordinated, discreetly pigmented, and lightly shaded to the lip form.

Now you'll always be perfectly made up, and small natural flaws are corrected. You can go to a sauna without a worry and rain is also no longer a problem, because your makeup is always on and it's near proof. You'll gain a completely new self-confidence lasting several years without any additional work!

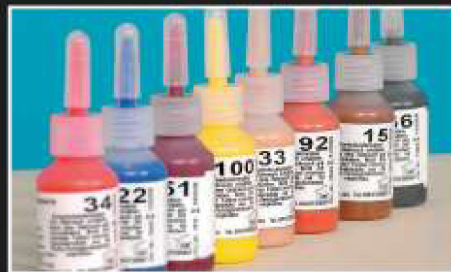

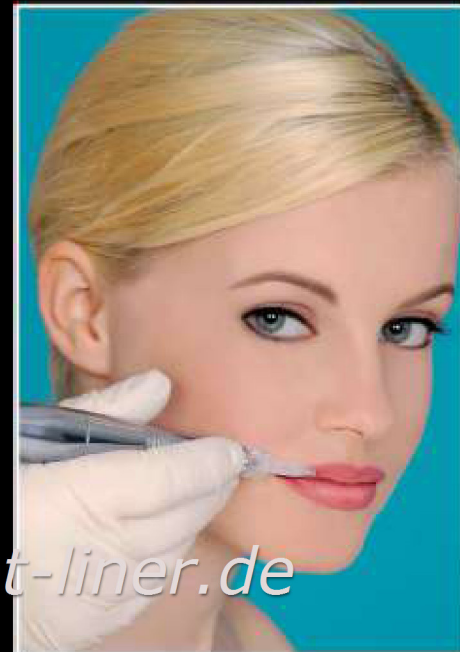

What is Permanent Makeup?

Using specialized fine needles, tested colors are deposited in the dermal layer of the skin. With our new generation of tools, the color pigments can be implanted gently and practically pain-free for eyebrow- eyeliner- and lip-pigmentation.



What are the risks?

Risks are practically eliminated because of a hygienically pure workspace, the use of consumable supplies (which were produced especially for the permanent makeup), gamma sterilized needles, needle nozzles and a separation of the pigmenting tool by color return flow protection. Of course, all material is disposable, and dermatological and certified colors are used according to the latest regulations. The pigmentation tools are all state-of-the-art. The needle hub is electronically stabilized up to 320/19,000 strokes per second/minute.

How long does permanent makeup last?

Here, skin type, demands on the skin, the customer's own pigmentation, and the colors used play an important role. Depending on these factors, the makeup can last from 2 to about 8 years. As a permanent makeup customer, we recommend that you have a specially trained Profi-Permanent artist in the Institute do your makeup. After about two years, you'll make a new appointment, where our specialists will determine whether the colors should be refreshed. A separate price will be arranged for this service.

Will the pigmentation be very painful for me?

Pigmentation is a procedure that you will feel. However, an appropriate amount of topical anesthetic is used to minimize pain. You will feel a slight itching or tickling that may be unpleasant. As a rule, though, the treatment is very well tolerated. Please make note of the following points: Before the pigmentation, do not take any blood thinners such as aspirin. In addition, do not drink coffee, alcohol or take sedatives. You also have to fully trust the person carrying out the treatment; otherwise, no topical anesthetic will help!
